Cookies are small files, given ID tags, which are stored on a user's browser upon the latter's consent and are designed to hold a modest amount of data specific to a particular client and website. Data collected through the cookies can be accessed either by the web server or the user's computer.

Cookies allow us to remember your custom preferences (ex. language) and allow you to complete tasks without having to re-enter your information when browsing hence making browsing on our website easier. The purpose of using cookies is to distinguish you from other users of our website as well as to analyse trends and administer the website so that we can provide you with the best experience and also to improve the function of certain parts of our website.

Without the use of cookies, our website will treat you as a completely new visitor every time you access it. Except for essential cookies, all cookies will expire after 30 days. You can block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies, however such blocking may compromise your access to certain parts of our website.
